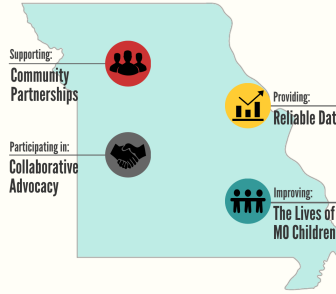


MISSOURI KIDS COUNT

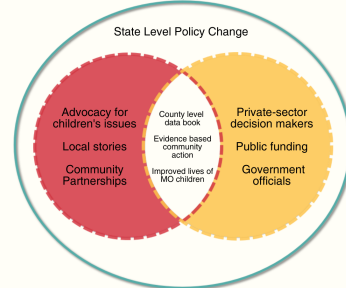
